Associate in Applied Science in Nursing to Bachelor of Science in Nursing

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for AAS in Nursing at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing at McKendree University.

Admission Requirements

Upon completion of the requirements leading to the Associate in Applied Science Degree in Nursing, KCTCS graduates who meet McKendree's admission requirements of a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average and proof of an unencumbered nursing license will be selected for admission to the Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing. McKendree's Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing program is available at several locations in Kentucky and online. Apply at apply.mckendree.edu.

Degree Requirements

McKendree University accepts the AAS in Nursing from KCTCS as fulfilling all general education requirements. Students must have a minimum of 120 credits to receive a Bachelor of Science in Nursing. McKendree accepts up to 90 hours in transfer credit. Residency with McKendree is a minimum of 30 hours. It is possible to double up on McKendree University nursing courses and complete the required nursing curriculum within one year.

General Transfer Requirements

- Apply for admission apply.mckendree.edu.
- Enrollments accepted five times per year.
- 10% tuition discount for all KCTCS graduates enrolled in a McKendree Worldwide program.*
- Phi Theta Kappa 15% tuition discount available for KCTCS graduates enrolled in a McKendree Worldwide program.*
- Active duty military \$250 per credit hour tuition rate and no additional fees when enrolled in a McKendree Worldwide program.*
- Transfer scholarships available to students attending the Lebanon, IL campus.
